Restaurants Near the Metropolitan Museum of Art for Families

Whether you live in NYC or are just visiting, the Metropolitan Museum of Art is probably on your list of places to explore with kids. In addition to its engaging exhibits, the Met is known for its top-notch family programs and drop-in art-making opportunities for all ages.

Eli's Table

1413 Third Avenue, between 80th and 81st Streets

Part of the famous Eli Zabar family of establishments, this low-key eatery offers table service with wine in the evenings and a classic New York brunch on weekends. The brunch menu includes hearty dishes with a Jewish flavor, including matzo ball soup and cheese blintzes with applesauce and sour cream. There's plenty of smoked fish on the menu, but also pancakes, granola, and a full kids' menu for the less adventurous.
