To Sauce: Pumpkins So Cute, You Could Eat Them Up

Just right for the season are these pumpkin-shaped pasta shells. The bag contains a mix of plain and spinach- and tomato-flavored pasta. I like them slicked with a sauce made by quickly sautéing garlic and slivered fresh sage, adding a few spoonfuls of pumpkin purée and thinning the mixture with pasta water.
